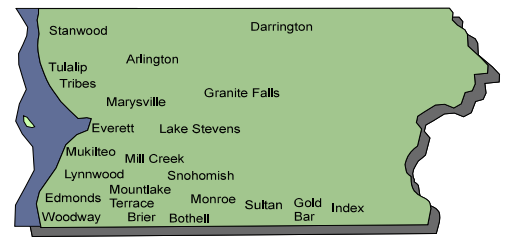

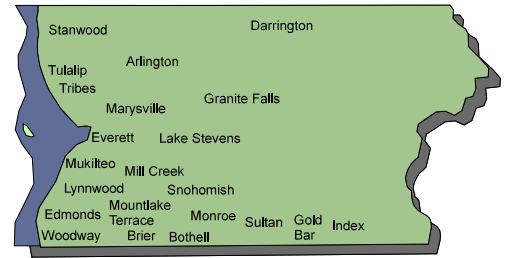

8 **a. 2020 Growth Monitoring Report (GMR)**

9 Steve Toy explained that the GMR is the foundation for completing the Buildable Lands  
10 Report next year. He walked the members through the data shown in the report. Mr. Toy  
11 explained that if the PAC chooses to forward the report to the Steering Committee today  
12 then it would be scheduled for their December 2, 2020, meeting.

14 Bill Trim moved to forward the GMR to the Steering Committee for their December 2,  
15 2020, meeting. Lauren Balisky seconded the motion and it passed unanimously.

17 **6. Discussion/Update Items**

18 **a. UW COVID-19 Mobility Survey; Results for Snohomish County**

19 Brian Lee explained that this survey asked a key question; what the commute trip  
20 reduction potential is as shown by this year's shut down due to COVID-19. He walked

25 **b. Buildable Lands Report Update**

26 Steve Toy reported that work was still on track to meet with all cities by Christmas.

28 **c. 2044 Initial Growth Targets – Process and Schedule**

29 Steve Toy walked the members through the projected schedule. The goal is for the PAC  
30 to consider these targets in June of 2021, and to forward SCT's recommendation to the  
31 County Council by the end of 2021.

33 The PAC members agreed to use a subcommittee for this work, using the same  
34 approach as with the previous growth targets. Steve Toy will invite members to be on the  
35 subcommittee by sending an emailed invitation in January.

37 **d. PSRC Regional Staff Committee Update (including VISION 2050)**

38 Laura Benjamin reported that technical guidance has been drafted. She also reported  
39 that the General Assembly had adopted VISION 2050 on October 29<sup>th</sup> as well as  
40 described other PSRC board activities.
