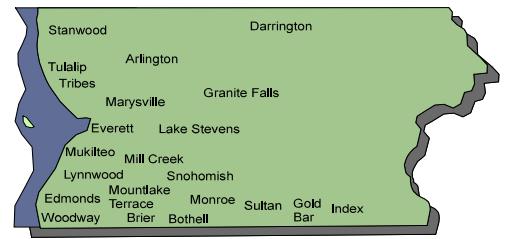

a. Introduction of new SCT Manager and PAC member introductions

Mike McCrary introduced the new SCT Manager, Ann Larson. Ms. Larson has served as a Senior Legislative Assistant in the Washington State Legislature for 44th Legislative District from 2006-2011, followed by several years at the United Way of Snohomish County as Labor Donor Relations & Community Liaison Manager, and most recently as the Northwest Regional Director for U.S. Senator Patty Murray since 2014.

Following the introduction of Ann Larson, PAC members held a roundtable of introductions. Members introduced themselves and discussed their current priorities and concerns especially in regard to the legislative session impacts to their jurisdictions. Priorities discussed were the status of Comprehensive Plan Updates, HB 1110, and HB 1337.

b. PSRC Update

Maggie Moore gave an update on PSRC. There are over 200 people registered for the 5/18 Planning Webinar for elected officials and planning commissioners.

A joint session with PSRC and Commerce is being planned to discuss the outcomes of the legislative session and what to include in the comprehensive plan updates. The date will be announced soon.
