Accident Investigation

On November 29, 2011 at approximately 6:50am, Sheriff's Office deputies responded to a vehicle accident involving a pedestrian in the 11900 block of 20th Street SE, Everett. Upon arrival, deputies learned a female, 14 years of age, had been crossing 20th Street SE when she was struck by a vehicle. Initial information indicates the female was not in a crosswalk or at an intersection at the time of the accident. The driver of the vehicle stopped and rendered aid to the female until medical personnel arrived on scene. The female sustained serious injuries and was transported to a local hospital for treatment. The Sheriff's Office Collision Investigation Unit responded to the scene and is handling the investigation. No driver information is available at this time.
