SMART Concludes Investigation into Use of Force Incident, SMART Case #22-04

EDMONDS, Wash. – The SMART Team Investigation into the officer involved use of force incident that occurred on April 22, 2022, at a motel in the 22100 block of Highway 99 has been completed. Investigators have forwarded the case to the Snohomish County Prosecutor’s Office for review. There will no longer be weekly updates regarding this case. The investigation is being conducted by the [Snohomish County Multiple Agency Response Team \(SMART\)](#). SMART is a team of investigators, evidence technicians, records specialist, and public information officers from various Snohomish County law enforcement agencies and Washington State Patrol, who respond to, and investigate, police use of force incidents. There are civilian community members that also serve on the SMART team per the Law Enforcement Training and Community Safety Act (LETSCA). When the SMART investigation is complete, results will be forwarded to the Snohomish County Prosecutor’s Office for review.
