SMART Case #23-03

EVERETT, Wash. – Detectives with the Snohomish County Multiple Agency Response Team (SMART) continue to investigate the March 22 shooting incident in the 8600 block of Evergreen Way that resulted in one officer being injured and one suspect deceased.

This remains an active investigation. Anyone with information related to the case is asked to call the Sheriff’s Office tipline at 425-388-3845.

The investigation is ongoing and all weekly updates for this case are posted on the SMART Investigations webpage.

The investigation is being conducted by the [Snohomish County Multiple Agency Response Team \(SMART\)](#). SMART is a team of investigators, evidence technicians, records specialist, and public information officers from various Snohomish County law enforcement agencies and Washington State Patrol, who respond to, and investigate, police use of force incidents. There are civilian community members that also serve on the SMART team per the Law Enforcement Training and Community Safety Act (LETSCA). When the SMART investigation is complete, results will be forwarded to the Snohomish County Prosecutor’s Office for review.
