## **Snohomish County Seeking Applicants For \$1.1 Million to Develop Affordable Multi-Unit Rental Housing Projects**

**SNOHOMISH COUNTY, Wash., October 11, 2023** – Snohomish County is announcing that a Notice of Funding Opportunity (NOFO) will be posted tomorrow and is encouraging nonprofit organizations, for-profit developers, and government agencies to submit applications to develop affordable multi-unit rental housing projects.

An estimated \$1.1 million in federal funds under the HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME) is anticipated to be available for the 2024 program year. Projects must benefit low- and moderate-income persons in Snohomish County.

Interested applicants are encouraged to participate in a Virtual Application Workshop on October 26, 2023, from 10:00 to 11:00 a.m. Details on eligibility, directions for participating in the workshop, and other program requirements are available at the following link:
