196th Street SE to be paved

Snohomish County Public Works is planning to pave the first 500 feet of 196th Street SE east from Yew Way before November of this year, weather permitting.

Improvements to the slope, sight distance, and angle at the intersection will be included in the paving project. The road surface will be widened to a 20-foot width, with ditches as necessary on both sides. A single-lane closure is likely to be in effect during construction, which is expected to last for two to three weeks.

The county is also considering options for improving an additional 1300 feet of 196th Street SE during 2015.
