

Eligibility Quick Reference

Two Categories of Eligibility

1. You must:

- Have been separated from your job through no fault of your own
(Lay-off, lack of work, termination under certain circumstances, quit due health conditions.)
- Be eligible for UI or have received and exhausted UI in the last 2 years.
- Be unlikely to return to your occupation.
(Occupation is in decline or little projected growth, lack the skills to be competitive, physically unable, other)

- OR -

2. Your income for the past 6 months must be less than amount listed for your family size on the table below

or

You must be receiving public assistance (Food Stamps, TANF, GAU).

FAMILY SIZE	6-month Income Level
1	\$8,935
2	\$11,980
3	\$15,025
4	\$18,070
5	\$21,115
6	\$24,160

Additional Eligibility Requirements

You also must:

- Be legally entitled to work in the U.S. (Citizen or eligible non-citizen)
- Have lived or worked in Snohomish County (priority given)
- Be 18 years or older
- Males born after 12/31/1959 have to be registered with selective service
