FINDINGS AND DECISION

DECISION SUMMARY

The City of Snohomish's Proposed 16th Street Annexation (BRB No. 01-2014) is hereby **DENIED**.

PROCEDURAL HISTORY

On January 16, 2014, the City of Snohomish (the "City") filed a notice of intention with the Washington State Boundary Review Board for Snohomish County (the "Board") proposing a petition method annexation of approximately 17.4 acres located contiguous to the city limits on the north and east city boundaries. The City authorized initiation of the annexation by Resolution 1309.

The Board's jurisdiction was invoked by Snohomish County and registered voters residing within the area being considered on March 17, 2014.

HEARING

On June 19, 2014, a quorum of the Board held a public hearing in public meeting room #2 on the first floor of the Robert J. Drewel Building, 3000 Rockefeller Avenue, Everett, WA. Notice of the hearing was given pursuant to

1 RCW 36.93.160. During the hearing, the Board heard testimony from
2 representatives of the City, Snohomish County, and members of the public. The
3 Board considered all written material and other evidence that was timely submitted
4 to the Board, including but not limited to the notice of intention and attachments,
5 supplemental documentation submitted by the City, material from Snohomish
6 County, and items submitted by citizens.

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8 Following testimony, the Board deliberated in open session. The Board
9 discussed the factors identified in RCW 36.93.170, the objectives stated in RCW
10 36.93.180, and the Board's authority under chapter 36.93 RCW, as applied to the
11 proposed annexation. Prior to the Board reaching any conclusions based upon the
12 discussion of the factors and objectives, the City requested to withdraw the
13 proposed annexation proposal from consideration. Thereafter, the hearing was
14 closed.

15 16 17 **DECISION**

18 **NOW THEREFORE**, the Board finds:

- 19 1. The jurisdiction of the Board was properly invoked and the Board has
20 jurisdiction over this matter.
- 21 2. The City has requested that the proposed annexation be withdrawn
22 from the Board's consideration.

24 Based upon the above findings, the City's proposed 16th Street Annexation
25 is **DENIED**.


