PUBLIC NOTICE DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE (DNS)

PROJECT NAME: Wenberg Boat Launch and Waterfront Renovation (14-115417)

DESCRIPTION OF PROPOSAL: Shoreline Management Substantial Development application and associated development permits for the renovation of the existing boat launch and waterfront area at Wenberg County Park, a 45 acre park site on the eastern shore of Lake Goodwin in Stanwood, Washington. Existing facilities are inadequate to support use levels and do not meet current Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) standards. Proposed improvements include the following:

- Two ADA parking stalls added to the existing parking lot
- ADA access provided to beach and picnic areas
- Construct ADA-accessible overwater walkway around the swimming area. Walkway will be up to 10 feet wide, 650 feet long, and supported by steel piles. It will include a recycled plastic deck and fiberglass grating. It will accommodate recreational fishing.
- Rebuild boat ramp.
- Define traffic lanes to boat launch.
- Add drop off area:
 - ADA parking for one boat, trailer, and car
 - 40 ft. wide boat launch
 - extended precast concrete boat ramp
 - floats (112 feet long x 8 feet wide) with north side moorage for personal watercraft
- Add a 110 ft. long x 8 ft. wide moorage float on the north side of the swim area.
- All picnic tables placed on slabs for access and maintenance.
- Add one new picnic shelter.

LOCATION OF PROPOSAL: The park site is located on the east shore of Lake Goodwin.

THRESHOLD DETERMINATION: The lead agency for this proposal has determined that it does not have a probable significant adverse impact on the environment. An environmental impact statement (EIS) is not required under RCW 43.21C.030(2)(c). The lead agency has determined that the requirements for environmental analysis, protection, and mitigation measures have been adequately addressed in the county's development regulations and

comprehensive plan adopted under chapter 36.70A RCW, and in other applicable local, state, or federal laws and rules, as provided by RCW 43.21C.240 and WAC 197-11-158. Our agency will not require any additional mitigation measures under chapter 30.61 SCC.

PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD: This DNS is subject to a 14 day comment period. Written comments may be submitted by mail or e-mail to the lead agency's contact person. See name and address below. Comments must be received by 5 p.m., July 31, 2015.

APPEALS: Pursuant to SCC 30.61.300(10) this DNS may be appealed to the state Shorelines Hearings Board together with the appeal of the underlying Shoreline Permit. Appeal of this DNS is not allowed as a separate appeal, but must be combined with the appeal of the underlying shoreline permit and filed within the time period specified for the appeal of the shoreline permit. Appeal of a shoreline permit shall be filed with the state pollution control hearings board pursuant to RCW 90.58.180.
