






On January 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2014, **1,272** persons in **922** households did not have a permanent place to stay. Those numbers include:

- 314 (26%) were under the age of 18
  - 83 of those were unaccompanied youth
  - 231 were in families with children
- 71 were Veterans
  - 67 were male, 3 were female, and 1 was unknown
  - Approximately 37% indicated they have a permanent physical disability
- 29% were of a minority population







### % Minority by housing situation






## Household Size by housing category















#### Causes for Veterans and Chronic Homeless




