On June 11, 1994, human remains were discovered at the north end of Lake Stickey in unincorporated Everett, Washington. The remains are of a bi-racial male, black/white, estimated to be over 40 years of age, 5'11" tall and 180 - 200 pounds. He was in the lake for an unknown amount of time. Clothing included Levi's jeans (33x36), Hanes underwear (waist size 30), black socks and high top work boots with braided string laces and a vulcan sole. The cause of death is multiple gunshot wounds to the head. The manner of death is Homicide.

This drawing is by a forensic artist and is an interpretation of what this person may look like or may look similar to. Hairstyle and color and eye color are guesses. Our hope is that you see a resemblance in the likeness and be able to provide more information that may lead to an identity.
