

What is Family Drug Treatment Court?

The Family Drug Treatment Court is a voluntary court program designed to help parents with substance abuse problems whose children are in the legal custody of DCFS.

FDTC provides extra support & accountability while parents are working on their recovery from active addiction to drugs and/or alcohol.

During their journey of recovery, the FDTC Judge and Team help parents to overcome barriers that prevent the successful completion of their DCFS case plan.



The Benefits of FDTC to You & Your Children !

- Frequent appearances before the Judge to demonstrate compliance.
- Expedited access to Chemical Dependency Treatment Services.
- Improved chance of reunification through increased accountability (more than 90% of our graduates have been reunified with their children).
- Access to additional services, like Individual Counseling, Employment and Education Counseling and Specialized Services for your children.
- Support from other parents in FDTC going through the recovery process: you are not alone!

How do I apply to FDTC?

1. Call the FDTC Coordinator at **(425) 388-7887** to schedule an Intake Screening appointment (lasts about 60 minutes). You will receive a referral to a full Chemical Dependency Assessment on this date.
2. Observe Court 2 times in Dept. 3 on the 2nd Floor of the Snohomish County Courthouse (3000 Rockefeller, Everett) at 3:00PM every Friday — ***please be sure to sign-in!***
3. Attend your Chemical Dependency Assessment (if applicable).
4. Submit an Agreed Order of Dependency for the case entering FDTC.

After completing these 4 items you may be eligible to attend an Interview for FDTC. If you pass your Interview, you'll be given the option of entering FDTC on the next court date!
