**Notice**

Snohomish County is making the Draft 2016 Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (Draft 2016 CAPER) available for public review and comment for 18 days – September 1, 2017 through September 18, 2017.

**Information about the CAPER**

Snohomish County, in consortium with the cities and towns in the county, receives three grants from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD):

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
- Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG)
- HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME).

The funds are used to support affordable housing and community development projects in the county that primarily benefit low- and moderate-income people and neighborhoods. The Draft 2016 CAPER describes how the grant funds were used from July 1, 2016 through June 30, 2017, and assesses progress towards annual and five-year goals for the three grant programs.
