

Notice of Land Disturbing Activity (LDA)

Stormwater Facility Retrofit at 156th St. SW and 34th Place W. (Oak Manor)



Project Description:

Snohomish County Public Works, Surface Water Management Division, proposes to replace a failing stormwater detention pipe located under the east side of 34th Pl. W., near 156th St. SW. A larger detention pipe will be installed to reduce high flows downstream and improve water quality.

The work will include excavation of the east side of the roadway and sidewalk to remove the existing pipe and install new stormwater and drainage pipes. The new pipes will connect to the existing stormwater system under 156th St. SW. After installing the pipes, the work area will be repaved and new curb, gutter, and sidewalk installed along the east side of the road. New curb ramps will also be installed at the intersection.

Timing and Project Location:

Construction is planned for Summer 2017. This project will occur at the intersection of 156th St. SW and 34th Pl. W. Earthwork Quantities:
Excavation: 1002 cubic yards Fill: 750 cubic yards
Net: 252 cubic yards
