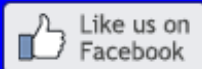

SR 530 Slide Property Buy Out - On Tuesday, June 23rd Snohomish County was notified by Washington's congressional delegation that the County will receive \$6.6 million to assist in purchasing properties that were destroyed by the SR 530 Slide. The initial request to FEMA was in the amount of \$9.4 million. I have been advised that the funding received would help to get the process started and that County staff is hopeful that there may be additional funds granted. The 43 victims and their families are never far from my thoughts and prayers. It is my hope that the news that the County is receiving this funding will ease, in some small way, the burden that they've felt over the past fifteen months. Fireworks - Fireworks may legally be sold in unincorporated Snohomish County between noon on June 28th and noon on July 6th of each year. Unincorporated Snohomish County allows the discharge of fireworks on July 4th only. The hours when fireworks may be legally discharged begins at 9:00pm and ends at 12:00am on July 5th.
