Eligibility

Open to children who are three or four years old by August 31.

In addition to income guidelines, we consider other family circumstances to prioritize children for enrollment such as:

- Homelessness
- Participation in child welfare services
- Other risk factors

Children in foster or kinship care are automatically eligible.

Children transitioning from Early Head Start or Early Intervention programs are eligible at age three.
