#### How to vote

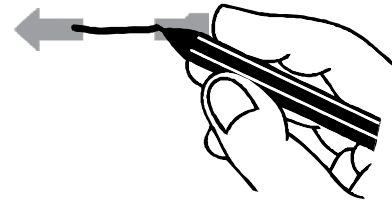
Mark your vote with a single line. Voting more than once per question or race will cancel that vote.

Levy Lid Lift

The Board of Snohomish County Fire Protection District No. 4 adopted Resolution No. 489 concerning a proposition to maintain and adequately fund District operations.

This proposition would authorize the District to restore its regular property tax levy to an amount not to exceed \$1.50 per \$1,000.00 of assessed valuation for collection in 2018 and authorizes annual increases of up to 6% for each of the five succeeding years to provide adequate funding to maintain service levels. The maximum allowable levy in 2022 shall serve as the base for subsequent levy limitations as provided by Chapter 84.55 RCW.

Restoring Regular Property Tax Levy

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 7, Snohomish County, Washington, adopted Resolution No. 2017-5 re-authorizing a regular property tax levy of \$1.50 per \$1,000. This proposition would authorize the District to restore and maintain its regular property tax levy of \$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed valuation for 2017 (the same levy that existed in 2016) and thereafter subject to any otherwise applicable statutory dollar rate limitations. The dollar amount of this levy would be used for the purpose of computing the limitations for subsequent levies under RCW 84.55.050. Should this proposal be approved?

Proposition No. 1

Creation of South Snohomish County Fire & Rescue Regional Fire Authority

The City Council of the City of Lynnwood and the Board of Commissioners of Snohomish County Fire Protection District No. 1 have adopted a Joint Resolution approving the South Snohomish County Fire & Rescue Regional Fire Authority Plan ("Plan") concerning the creation of a Regional Fire Protection Service Authority.

This proposition would approve the Plan and create the South Snohomish County Fire & Rescue Regional Fire Authority ("Authority"), effective October 1, 2017, to provide fire protection and emergency medical services in the City and District. The Authority would be funded by property tax (\$1.50 per \$1,000 of assessed value) and other sources identified in the Plan. The City and District levy capacities would be reduced to offset the Authority's levy.
