

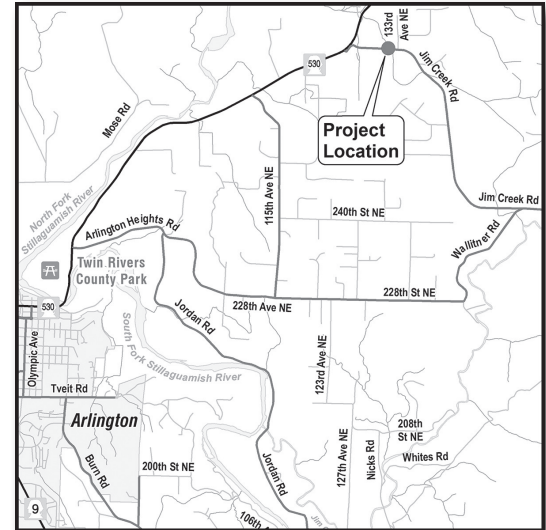


# Jim Creek Road Closure July 8-22

A Snohomish County Public Works Surface Water Management Division project will replace an undersized culvert under Jim Creek Road to retain the safety and integrity of the road and reduce private property flooding. The culvert is located on Jim Creek Road, northeast of Arlington between SR530 and 133rd Avenue NE.

A full road closure at the culvert will be in effect from 6:30 a.m. Monday, July 8 through 5 p.m. Monday, July 22.
