Snohomish County Public Works Hosting Open House on Proposed Road Projects near Bothell, Alderwood Manor and Brier

Projects include 14th Ave W road extension and improvements to the intersection at Locust Way and Larch Way/Logan Road

EVERETT, Wash., June 12, 2017 –South Snohomish County is experiencing rapid population growth and increased traffic. Snohomish County Public Works is working on two potential road projects in the Bothell/Brier/Alderwood area to help meet traffic demands. In keeping the community aware of these projects and their current statuses, Public Works will be hosting an open house to discuss two potential road designs and project timelines.

The proposed projects are:

- [14th Ave W Extension Project](#) – Creating a two lane road extension to connect Locust Way at 215th Pl SW to 228th St SW.
- [Locust Way and Larch Way/Logan Road](#) - Intersection improvements include adding a traffic signal with left- and right-turn pockets.

Where: Mountlake Terrace High School in the Hub; 21801 44th Ave W, Mountlake Terrace, WA 98043

What: Residents of the area, commuters, and families of nearby schools are invited to discuss the two projects. Staff will be available to answer questions about the proposed road extension and intersection improvements.
