

NOTICE OF PROPOSED RULE REPEAL

SNOHOMISH COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

The following described rule is proposed for repeal pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 30.82 Snohomish County Code (SCC).

Notice Date: October 22, 2017

Rule Title: Policy 6620 Encroachment

Proposed Rule Repeal: Snohomish County Planning and Development Services (PDS) proposes to repeal Policy 6620 in its entirety. Policy 6620 provides a definition of encroachments and specific processes to resolve any encroachments. The policy is no longer necessary to address encroachments. The policy was originally promulgated and is currently proposed for repeal pursuant to the rulemaking process under Chapter 30.82 SCC. A copy of Policy 6620 can be obtained on the PDS Rule webpage noted below.

Request for Comments: Comments on the proposed rules are requested from interested citizens.

Comment Period: Comments must be submitted in writing on or before **November 13, 2017**.

Where to Submit Comments: Comments should be submitted to the contact person at the mailing address or e-mail listed below.

Review Process: After reviewing and considering the comments submitted in response to this notice, the PDS Director may approve the proposed rule repeal in whole or in part, with or without changes. The Director will provide notice of any action taken with respect to the proposed rule repeal by submitting a copy to the clerk of the County Council, giving public notice in the county newspaper of record (*The Herald*), and sending copies to any person who submitted written comments on the proposed rule repeal.

Request for County Council Review: If approved by PDS, the rule repeal may reviewed by the Snohomish County Council upon written request by an interested person, if such request is submitted to the PDS Director or contact person listed below no later than 120 days after rule repeal approval. No other formal appeal opportunity is available.
