

NOTICE OF RULE REPEAL

SNOHOMISH COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING AND DEVELOPMENT SERVICES

The following described rule is hereby repealed pursuant to the provisions of Chapter 30.82 Snohomish County Code (SCC).

Notice Date: November 22, 2017

Rule Title: Policy 6620 Encroachment

Repealed Rule: Snohomish County Planning and Development Services (PDS) has repealed Policy 6620 in its entirety. Policy 6620 provided a definition of encroachments and specific processes to resolve any encroachments. The policy is no longer necessary to address encroachments. The policy was promulgated pursuant to the rulemaking process under Chapter 30.82 SCC. A copy of former Policy 6620 can be obtained on the PDS Rule webpage noted below.

Decision: The PDS Director has approved repeal of the rule in its entirety. This Notice of Rule Repeal is being submitted to the clerk of the County Council, published in the County newspaper of record (The Herald), and sent to all persons who submitted written comments.
