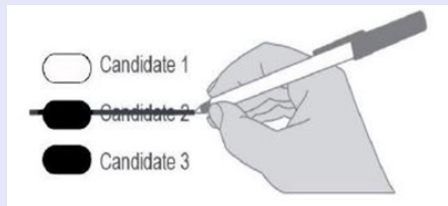

Replacement Educational Programs and Operation Levy

The Board of Directors of Darrington School District No. 330 adopted Resolution No. 377-02-18, concerning a proposition to finance educational programs and operation expenses. This proposition would authorize the District to levy the following excess taxes, in place of an expiring levy, on all taxable property within the District, for support of the District's General Fund educational programs and operation expenses not funded by the State of Washington:

Merger of Snohomish County Fire Protection District No. 28 into Snohomish County Fire Protection District No. 26

The Board of Fire Commissioners of Fire Protection District No. 28, Snohomish County, Washington, adopted Resolution No. 2018-01 concerning a merger into Snohomish County Fire Protection District No. 26. This proposition would authorize Snohomish County Fire Protection District No. 28 to merge into Snohomish County Fire Protection District No. 26 creating one fire protection district to provide fire and emergency medical services for the areas currently served by the two districts.

Sno-Isle Intercounty Rural Library District Proposition No. 1

Levy Rate Proposition

The Board of Trustees of Sno-Isle Intercounty Rural Library District adopted Resolution No. 17-06 concerning an increase in its regular property tax levy. This proposition would authorize the District to restore its regular property tax levy rate to \$0.47 per \$1,000 of assessed value for collection in 2019 in order to continue to provide the current level of library service throughout the District. The resulting dollar amount of the 2019 levy would be used for the purpose of computing subsequent levy limitations as provided by chapter 84.55 RCW.
