35th Ave SE – Phase I Road Improvement Project

Where is the project located?

Road improvements will be made on 35th Ave SE between 180th St SE to Seattle Hill Road. See map for details.

When is construction anticipated to begin and how long will it last?

Phase I construction is targeted to begin in May 2018 and it is anticipated to take two years to complete.

What are the phase I project improvements?

- Widening the roadway to include a center turn lane and bike lanes
- Adding sidewalks and planter strips
- Improving stormwater detention and treatment facilities

Why is Snohomish County doing these improvements?

The Mill Creek/Bothell area is experiencing rapid population growth. To meet traffic and pedestrian demands, Public Works is working on multiple road improvement projects in the unincorporated county area.

Will there be road closures or traffic delays?


It is anticipated that two lanes will be open during construction but single-lane closures are possible on weekdays. Some weekend work will take place with full road closures.

What is the estimated construction cost of this project?

The estimated cost of phase I construction is \$9 million.

How is this project being paid for?

Snohomish County has acquired \$7.1 million in grants. The remaining \$1.9 million is being paid for with local funds.



Where and when will the second phase of this project take place?

Phase II will include road improvements on 35th Ave SE between SR 524 and 180th St SE. Construction for phase II is tentatively scheduled for 2020-2021.
