Mr. Eastin -

Please include my deep concern regarding the safety and liability issues around the possibility of a massive land slide onto the potential Point Wells site. The implications are beyond estimation.

My concern is well founded since there have always been constant slides in that area, often enough to halt all train passage on the BNSF Railway between Seattle and Everett. Just yesterday, a mud slide measuring 20 feet high and 200 feet long came down a cliff 100 feet above the tracks, according to a BNSF spokesperson.

This must be fully addressed in the Point Wells EIS and carefully considered by Washington State, Snohomish County, King County, City of Shoreline, independent geologists, seismologists, oceanographers, insurance carriers, financial interests, construction bidders and others.
