I'd like to add Fremont, Linden and Firlands Way to your list of streets with too much cut-through traffic. Much of it is from King's Garden students, parents and residents, the Park and Ride and other by-passing Aurora to avoid the lights. N 185th and Aurora is a choke point where all the traffic coming up the hill that doesn't cut through the neighborhoods will back-up for blocks, likely driving even more cars onto side streets. And it sounds like the City is trying to revise it's code so it won't have to consider concurrent construction like the new low-income housing being constructed behind Ronald Church or the additional buildings planned Crista.
