Subject: BSRE urging County to impose Shoreline's levels of service

Here's an interesting passage from Gary Huff's October 9, 2012 letter to the County Council, written as the Council was considering Ordinances 12-068 and 12-069:

"We urge the Council to adopt and impose Shoreline's levels of service to effectively limit and mitigate traffic impacts within its jurisdiction."

Note that with a 3-lane Richmond Beach Road, Shoreline's level of service standards will be shattered at extremely low levels of traffic volume from Point Wells.

When will everyone stop trying to squeeze traffic from a size 16 Urban Center or size 14 Urban Village into a size 3 road network?
