I would like to continue to express my concern about the Point Wells project. The amount of construction and the number of expected residents is too large to sustain. There is clearly not enough access via a 2 lane road. There is no train station planned. Shoreline/King County will be the default provider of emergency services to a Snohomish county town. Taxpayers in King County will bear the cost of services outside their county and Snohomish County taxpayers will not. There will be a significant adverse impact of noise, traffic, people etc coming back and forth through a quiet neighborhood. These things are obvious to everyone. At the least, the project should be significantly smaller than planned.

Please use good judgement in the development of Point Wells, and please avoid being swayed by a very big and very rich developer. Unfortunately for our neighborhood, you have much to gain and little to lose while we are the opposite.
