Honorable Hearing Examiner, Snohomish County,

We, as 45 year residents of Richmond Beach, Washington, are strongly opposed to any additional extensions of time for BSRE to produce an acceptable DEIS for the following reasons, among many others:

Traffic in Richmond Beach/Shoreline would likely be impacted to such a great extent that no amount of mitigation would resolve it. This will negatively impact our and our neighbor's safety and quality of life.

The mitigation offered by BSRE does not improve the traffic situation, it only asks Shoreline to ignore its level of service standards or to undo safety improvements currently being implemented.

BSRE has been granted 3 extensions totaling 4 years from the original due date for their reply to 42 issues in their application.

A number of these issues are of such a critical nature that they should result in denial of the application.

After waiting years for adequate response to the issues, there is no reason to believe BSRE will be more diligent if granted another delay.

We strongly believe that these problems are critical enough for you to reject the application.
