I am writing to strongly recommend denial of the Point Wells application as the County has recommended. In addition I strongly recommend that you deny the developer any more extensions.

I will simply address one major concern that I have, although there are several other concerns that are paramount.

I moved into Woodway in 2003. At that time, traffic was manageable although wasn't necessary addressed by the Woodway mayor and council. Over the years, traffic, particularly bicycle and motorcycle and big truck traffic has increased tremendously. It is not uncommon for schools of motorcycles to speed through Woodway morning and night. Any development at Point Wells would simply be disastrous to the already burgeoning traffic issues. The idea of 3000 + condos necessitating 2000 + trips daily would be more than disastrous.

It is absolutely unreasonable that the developer would impact Woodway and surrounding environs contributing to the already present traffic issues.

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It is now known that truck drivers have "found" the way through Woodway to avoid the congestion on Edmonds Way and 100<sup>th</sup> coming to and from the ferry. If it's already an issue, what will it be like if the developer has his/her way? Unbelievable.

I strong recommend that you deny the Point Wells application on the issue of traffic alone.
