GMA Overview

"It is in the public interest that citizens, communities, local governments, and the private sector cooperate and coordinate with one another in comprehensive land use planning." RCW 36.70A.010.

Comprehensive Planning

Snohomish County jurisdictions must plan for:

Land use Housing

Capital facilities Utilities

Rural lands Transportation

Economic development Parks and recreation

- Consistency/coordination between jurisdictional plans
- Must plan for Essential Public Facilities

Essential Public Facilities


- Airports are defined as Essential Public Facilities (EPFs)
- Must inventory airports and plan for future distribution and locations
- Jurisdictions must discourage incompatible uses adjacent to airports through comprehensive plans and development regulations

Essential Public Facilities

 No comprehensive plan or development regulations may preclude the siting of essential public facilities

**Note: "Siting" has been interpreted to include the expansion of airport services.

What Do Local Plans Say about Paine Field? Future Land Use Designations



Snohomish County Comprehensive Plan

General Policy Plan - Capital Facilities Goal 8:

"Develop investment strategies for Paine Field to support and enhance its role as a general aviation and industrial commercial facility consistent with the Airport Master Plan."

City of Mukilteo Comprehensive Plan

- Discusses concerns and mitigation options to address noise and traffic impacts from Paine Field
- Supports 1978/79 MRD; MRD shaped city's land use decisions
- Opposed to expansion of Paine Field for commercial aviation use, while recognizing that GMA prohibits a city from precluding EPFs.

City of Everett Comprehensive Plan

- Supports the Paine Field Master Plan Update
- Plan based on assumption that general aviation role will continue, but also anticipates a reevaluation of the MRD
- Policies "address the need to protect Paine Field from the encroachment from incompatible land uses."

Future Planning Issues

Future land use planning will continue to implement the decision of the MRD review panel, consistent with GMA.
