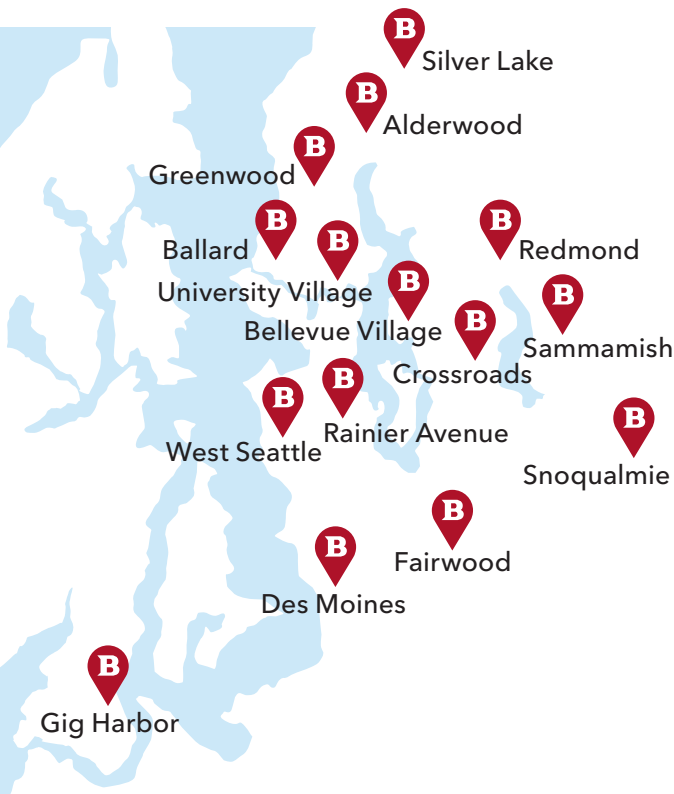


CareClinic can be found at 15 Bartell Drug locations
