17 Section 1. Snohomish County Code Section 4.25.050, last amended by
18 Amended Ordinance No. 12-097 on December 10, 2012, is amended to read:

20 **4.25.050 Use of fund.**

21 (1) The resources of the chemical dependency/mental health program fund shall
22 be used solely for the purpose of providing for the operation or delivery of chemical
23 dependency or mental health treatment programs and services and for the operation or
24 delivery of therapeutic court programs and services as allowed by state law, except as
25 follows:
26

27 (a) A portion of the revenue provided to the chemical dependency/mental
28 health program fund by moneys collected under the tax imposed by SCC 4.25.010 may
29 be used to supplant the costs of providing for the operation or delivery of chemical
30 dependency or mental health treatment programs and services previously funded by the
31 county general fund as follows (~~notwithstanding any authorization for a higher amount~~
32 ~~of supplanting under state law~~):
33

34 (i) in 2013, no more than 30 percent of the total collected in 2013;

35 (ii) in 2014, no more than 25 percent of the total collected in 2014;

36 (iii) in 2015, no more than ~~(45)~~ 20 percent of the total collected in
37 2015;


38 (iv) in 2016, no more than ~~(five)~~ 10 percent of the total collected in

2 (b) For the purposes of this section, "programs and services" includes, but
3 is not limited to, treatment services, case management, and housing that are a
4 component of a coordinated chemical dependency or mental health treatment program
5 or service.


7 (2) Contracts and contract amendments with private sector providers of home
8 care services, chemical dependency or mental health treatment services, or therapeutic
9 court services that are approved by the county executive under this section must be
10 awarded in a manner consistent with contracting policies adopted under SCC
11 2.400.067, if applicable.


