For the past 25 years, Lake Goodwin and Shoecraft residents and Snohomish County have partnered to control invasive Eurasian watermilfoil. Work is funded by an aquatic plant fee paid by local residents and Surface Water Management utility charges. ### Proposed Annual Aquatic Plant Fees for 2020-2025

- The current annual fee is \$60 for lakefront parcels and \$12 for parcels with community beach access.
- The fee will expire on December 31, 2019 unless renewed by Snohomish County Council.
- The eight-member citizen advisory committee recommends a fee increase in order to:
  - o Continue and improve control efforts
  - o Establish a reserve fund in 2020 to be ready to respond rapidly to large infestations
