*1 Sentencing Condition Violation hearings (in-custody) - when a court holiday falls on a Monday, the cases will be heard in the Tuesday session.

*2 Sentencing Condition Violation & Quash hearings (out-of-custody) – when a court holiday falls on a Monday or Tuesday, the out of custody cases will not be heard.

*3 Criminal warrant quash calendar (other than community supervision warrants) - when a court holiday falls on a Monday, this session will be held on Tuesday.

*4 Criminal Hearing Sentencing – When a court holiday falls on a Monday or Tuesday, this session will be cancelled.

*5 Plea/Sentencing-In Custody – when a court holiday falls on a Wednesday, the session will be cancelled

*6 Post-conviction Motions calendar - motions to seal, vacate conviction, for certificate of discharge, certificate of restoration of opportunity, hearings to confirm RALJ matters are ready for assignment for oral argument, motions to extend time periods for filing briefs and motions to dismiss RALJ appeals, relief from duty to register (all case types). **Motions regarding financial obligations are heard WITHOUT ORAL ARGUMENT-Parties do NOT need to appear.** When a court holiday falls on a Monday or Tuesday, this calendar will be not be heard.

*7 Criminal Motions – any hearing to last longer than 10 minutes is sent to the assigned Criminal Motions judge in the rotating department (**Extended Criminal Motions**). When a court holiday falls on Thursday, this calendar will not be heard that day. When a court holiday falls on Friday, this calendar will be heard on the last court day of the week.

*8 Criminal omnibus hearings – When a court holiday falls on Thursday and Friday, the Wednesday session will increase in limits and hear both in and out of custody cases. If it falls on an individual Wednesday, Thursday or Friday, the sessions will not be heard that day.

*9 Criminal Trial Call – heard by the Presiding Judge in courtroom C304. When a court holiday falls on Friday, this calendar will be heard on the last court day of the week.

*10 **Sentencings- Criminal Motions** – heard in the rotating department by the criminal motions Judge. When a court holiday falls on Thursday, this calendar will not be heard.

*11 Video Criminal Calendar - Arraignments, continuances, other in custody motions. When a court holiday falls on Friday, this calendar will be heard at 2pm on the last court day of the week, instead of the 1pm calendar.

*12 Criminal Docket - including arraignments, trial continuances, waiver of jury trial, stays, reinstate bail and continuances.

*13 Plea/Sentencing - each motion is docketed separately in the limits.

*14 Weapons Surrender Review (for criminal cases) hearings for mandatory surrender of firearms- when a court holiday falls on a Monday, the session will not be heard. Civil cases with weapons review are heard in front of the Commissioners.
