Notice

Snohomish County is making the Draft 2018 Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (Draft 2018 CAPER) available for public review and comment for 15 days – September 9, 2019 through September 24, 2019.

Information about the CAPER

Snohomish County, in consortium with the cities and towns in the county, receives three grants from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD):

- Community Development Block Grant (CDBG)
- Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG)
- HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME)

The funds are used to support affordable housing and community development projects in the county that primarily benefit low-and moderate-income people and neighborhoods. The Draft 2018 CAPER describes how the grant funds were used from July 1, 2018, through June 30, 2019, and assesses progress towards annual and five-year goals for the three grant programs.
