



Snohomish County seeking applicants for appointment to Gold Bar City Council

The Gold Bar City Council has requested the assistance of the Snohomish County Council in filling the vacant City Council position created by the resignation of Councilmember Elizabeth LaZella on February 6, 2013.

This request was made in accordance with RCW 42.12.070 after the city was unable to appoint a qualified individual within ninety days from the date the vacancy occurred.

To be qualified, an individual must have been a resident living within Gold Bar city limits for at least one year and be a registered voter at the time of appointment.

Individuals who are interested in serving the Gold Bar community in this capacity may apply by submitting a letter expressing their interest to the Snohomish County Council no later than the close of business on Friday, July 26, 2013. The successful candidate will be appointed to serve the unexpired term in accordance with state law.
