## **Historic Preservation Commission Announces 2020 Grant Application Round**

*Applications accepted beginning Nov. 18.*

**EVERETT, Wash., November 14, 2019** – The Snohomish County Historic Preservation Commission will begin accepting grant applications on Nov. 18, 2019. The grant program supports projects that promote the public’s access to county history. Funds are available through a competitive grant process to public and nonprofit agencies for professional development, public education, capital improvements, or collections enhancement.

Past grant awards have been used for development of books on Snohomish County history, interpretive signage, repair and/or rehabilitation of historic buildings and structures, and the purchase of archival materials and technology for museum collections and digitization of historical newspapers.
