EVERETT, Wash., Jan. 24, 2020 – Would you like to work outside and start a rewarding career? If so, plan to attend the Snohomish County Public Works Solid Waste and Road Maintenance job fair between 5:30 and 8 p.m., Wednesday, Jan. 29, 2020, at the Cathcart Operations Center in Snohomish.

The fair will provide an opportunity for applicants to ask questions about the county's seasonal and temporary laborer, site attendant, grounds maintenance, manual labor and traffic control positions.
