Redevelopment Projects (SCC 30.63A.310)

Full drainage plan required. Runoff from the replaced and new hard surfaces (including pavement, shoulders, curbs and sidewalks) shall meet minimum requirements 1 through 9 (SCC 30.63A.400 through 30.63A.605) if the new hard surfaces total 5,000 square feet or more and total 50 percent or more of the existing hard surfaces within the project limits. The project limits shall be defined by the length of the project and the width of the right-of-way.

Full drainage plan required. All redevelopment projects, except road-related projects covered by SCC 30.63A.310(5), shall comply with minimum requirements 1 through 9 (SCC 30.63A.400 through 30.63A.605) for the new plus replaced hard surfaces when:

- The total of the new plus replaced hard surfaces totals 5,000 square feet or more; and
- The value of proposed improvements including interior improvements exceeds 50 percent of the assessed value of the existing site improvements.
