Snohomish County Treasurer is Honored with Three National Appointments

EVERETT, Wash., August 7, 2020 – Brian Sullivan, Snohomish County Treasurer, was recently appointed to three key positions by the National Association of Counties President, Gary W. Moore (Boon County, Kentucky). The first, Vice-Chair of the Finance, Pensions and Intergovernmental Affairs Steering Committee, is where he will work on issues involving financial resources for counties, fiscal management, federal assistance (Covid-19), municipal borrowing, county revenues, federal budget, federal tax reform, elections, and Native American concerns.
