Snohomish County Closes North County Recycling and Transfer Station Due to Power Outage

NCRTS will be reopened once power is restored

EVERETT, Wash., Wednesday, Jan. 13, 2021 – Snohomish County has temporarily closed the North County Recycling and Transfer Station due to a power outage. All customers are encouraged to visit the Airport Road Recycling and Transfer Station or the Southwest Recycling and Transfer Station during the outage, as they are fully operational.

“We want to make sure that all customers have access to Solid Waste services and anticipate that this will be a short closure,” Snohomish County Solid Waste Director Matt Zybas said. “We are in contact with the Snohomish County Public Utility District and we will let the public know when the facility can reopen.”

All commercial haulers have been notified of the situation and updates will be sent out via email, as needed.
