RE: Second Notice: Requirement to relocate food distribution activities

Dear Zsofia:

After the visit to Paradise Valley Conservation Area on February 10th to assess the condition of the property, I am concerned that no apparent steps have been made toward moving the food distribution activity off the site as required by my letter dated January 22, 2021. During our February 10th phone conversation, you stated that you would be responding at some future date to the County's requirement to relocate the incompatible activity--however, to date I have heard nothing further in this regard from you.

To be clear of the County's intent: February 26th is the last day the County will allow the food distribution activity to occur at Paradise Valley Conservation Area. However, we continue to offer a suitable, no cost alternative site at the Evergreen Fair Park Building 607 and 608. The enclosed Facility License Agreement, upon execution, would allow for this activity to continue, consistent with the intent of the Governor's Proclamations concerning the pandemic.

As previously noted, the area currently used for food distribution is not included in your lease with Snohomish County—for any purpose. The property is designated only for duly permitted, low impact development of shared use parking. The unauthorized use of the property must cease on or before February 26th.

The County will be inspecting the site on March 1st. As of that date, we will take necessary actions to ensure that all activities not authorized in writing by the current lease shall cease.
