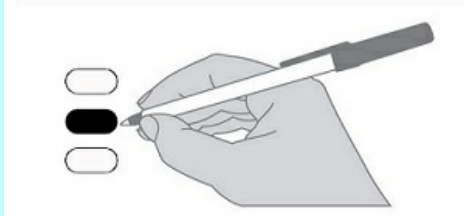

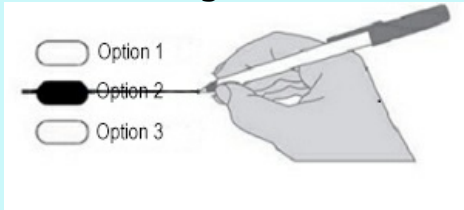

Levy Lid Lift for Fire Protection and
Emergency Medical Services

The Board of Fire Commissioners of
Snohomish County Fire Protection
District No. 19 adopted Resolution No.
2021-01, concerning a proposition to
restore the District's regular property
tax levy.

This proposition would provide funds
for limited purposes of fire protection,
prevention and emergency medical
services. It restores the District's
maximum regular levy rate for
collection in 2022 to \$1.50 per \$1,000
of assessed valuation (an
approximately \$0.14 increase) and
sets the limit factor for levy increases
in 2023 through 2027 at 106%. The
maximum allowable levy amount for
2027 will be used for the purpose of
computing the limitations for
subsequent levies under chapter
84.55 RCW.

Authorizing Regular Property Tax Levy

The Board of Fire Commissioners of
Snohomish County Fire Protection District
No. 21 (the "District"), adopted Resolution
No. 2021-07 concerning a proposition to
authorize the District's regular property
tax levy. This measure would authorize a
regular property tax levy of \$1.30 per
\$1,000 of assessed valuation in 2021 (for
collection in 2022) and an annual increase
in the limit factor of up to 106% (but not
to exceed the rate of \$1.50 per \$1,000 in
assessed valuation) for each of the five
succeeding years. The maximum
allowable levy in 2026, collected in 2027,
shall serve as the base for subsequent
levy limitations as provided by Chapter
84.55 RCW.
