MOTION #21-10**

WHEREAS, the current Business Solution Services procurement was issued by Workforce Snohomish on March 8, 2019 for a period of three years starting on July 1, 2019 and concluding on June 30, 2022, and

WHEREAS, Workforce Snohomish is an eligible entity to provide business services with WIOA Title I formula funds with authorization from the Snohomish County Future Workforce Alliance Board; and

WHEREAS, the demand for services by employers exceeds the current Business Solutions Services subrecipient capacity (contracted between July 1, 2021 – June 30, 2022); and

WHEREAS, moving the provision of business services in-house to Workforce Snohomish will result in increased capacity, stronger data collection and reporting, support system transformation, enable robust collaboration across workforce and economic development organizations, and improve outcomes for employers and job seekers alike; and


WHEREAS, Workforce Snohomish must develop a firewall policy to establish segregation of responsibilities and assure that no actual or perceived conflict of interest occurs in the provision of business services while maintaining proper oversight of all authorized WIOA Title I services; and

WHEREAS, program planning, development and increased capacity of business services is required during the period of January 1, 2022 through June 30, 2022; and

WHEREAS, Workforce Snohomish proposes the dedication PY21 approved budget funding in the amount of \$208,909 for the cost to enhance and transition the business services program to Workforce Snohomish;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Snohomish County Future Workforce Alliance Board of Directors votes to approve Motion 21-10 for Workforce Snohomish, to develop and deliver Business Services to support the recovery and resiliency of Snohomish County businesses commencing on January 1, 2022, and ending on June 30, 2025, with the provision that Workforce Snohomish remits a firewall policy to the Snohomish County Future Workforce Alliance prior to January 1, 2022, as required.
