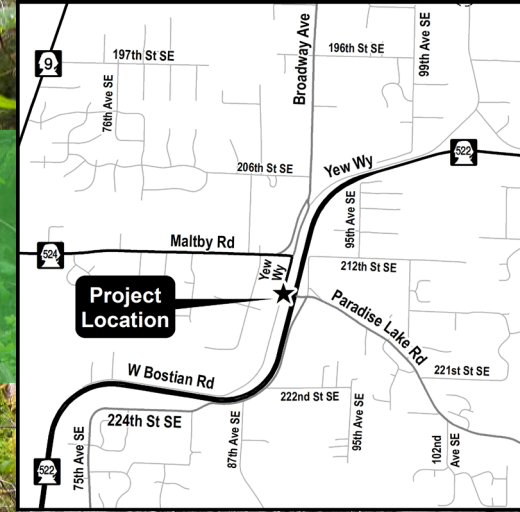


Notice of Land Disturbing Activity (LDA) Permit Application SR 524 (Yew Way) and Paradise Lake Road Intersection



Project Type: Road Improvement

Location: SR 524 (Yew Way) and Paradise Lake Road Intersection

Description:

Snohomish County Public Works proposes to widen and restripe SR 524 (Yew Way) at the intersection with Paradise Lake Road. The widening will allow for an additional storage in the southbound left-turn lane from Yew Way to Paradise Lake Rd/SR 522. The project is scheduled for construction beginning in summer of 2022. The project would include approximately 7,495 square feet of grading including 120 cubic yards of excavation (cut) and 6 cubic yards of fill. Approximately 8,409 square feet of clearing would occur.
