PREAMBLE

All preambles included in all previous versions of Emergency Orders re: Court Operations and all Addendums, Amendments, and Clarifications thereto are incorporated herein in their entirety; and

Pursuant to the authority given to this Court through Washington State Supreme Court Orders 25700-B-602 through B-646 (and any superseding or modified orders) and the authority granted to the Presiding Judge of Snohomish County Superior Court pursuant to GR 29, this Fifth Addendum to Emergency Order #15 shall be in effect according to the dates set forth herein.

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that:

1. **#39, relating to Commissioner Calendars** is amended to include the following:


C. Parties and attorneys shall appear physically for matters on the Commissioner Calendars unless the judicial officer to whom the matter is assigned has ordered otherwise. Except for hearings on petitions for protection orders or in the case of emergency, requests for remote appearances must be made by noon two (2) court days prior to the hearing. Any party requesting to appear remotely for a hearing on the Protection Order calendar shall do so using the forms entitled "Motion for Remote Appearance-Protection Order Hearing" and "Remote Appearance Request Information Form" located at

<https://www.snohomishcountywa.gov/5523/Snohomish-County-Superior-Court-Forms>.

Fully completed forms shall be emailed to: SuperiorCourtAdmin@snoco.org or dropped in the ex-parte basket outside the Confirmations lobby on the 1st floor of the courthouse. Both forms must be completed so that the requesting parties may be notified if their requests are granted. Any parties granted a remote appearance but who learn they are unable to appear shall notify the Court by calling 425-388- 3421 and by sending an email to SuperiorCourtAdmin@snoco.org before the hearing.

All provisions of Emergency Order # 15 and the first four addenda which are not superseded by this or any previous addendum shall remain in full force and effect.
